Important Registration Information!

Due to the implementation of a new online registration system, **ALL preschool families MUST come** to TOCS to register for 2022-2023.

*Registration for **CURRENT** families will be on Monday 3/21 from 8am-6pm.

*Registration for **NEW** families will be on Tuesday 3/22 from 8am-6pm.

*Application fee of \$25, due on registration day!

Enrollment fee of \$175, due upon completion of registration information.

DEBIT/CREDIT CARDS WILL BE ACCEPTED THIS YEAR!

Registration will be held in the **Chapel**. Families will **enter** the building **through the church office**.

It is critical that you attend this day. This will ensure your child has a spot in the preschool program for next year. However, if you are an existing TOCS family and unable to attend registration. Call the school office on Mon 3/21.
