“FACTS program reminder:



Please remember that it is your responsibility to keep our FACTS system up-to-date. Any basic information, such as address or phone number changes or pick-up permissions, as well as financial information and current CORRECT email addresses can all be accessed through your family portal account. Please check on your account occasionally, if you don't already, to make sure things are up-to-date. You should also check in the

financial section for billings that may be due; this is also where you can find statements of what has been paid to the school—especially useful at tax season! Just make sure to choose the correct school year you need to check on any time you log-on!

There are still a few families who have not completed their child's enrollment. Please understand that it is very important to complete the enrollment; students

cannot be loaded into classes and teachers cannot enter grades into the gradebook.

2022-2023 final billing for extended care was posted and emailed in June. If you used this service, please log-in to your family portal. All accounts from last school year should be taken care of immediately. Students are not allowed to carry over a balance from the previous school year.

Correct Procedure for Returning Orders:

Please remember, when returning orders and money to use separate payments. Each program is handled separately and orders and payment should be returned in separate **envelopes** labeled correctly.

Please **do not staple** checks or cash to order forms; they are too easy to tear getting them loose. If you use envelopes as we ask, there shouldn't be any need to use staples. **Enclose both the payment and**

the order form in the envelope! Please use a separate form for each child for every order, unless otherwise instructed.
