overall, and to Elijah Waddell for finishing 10th overall - Go Warriors!

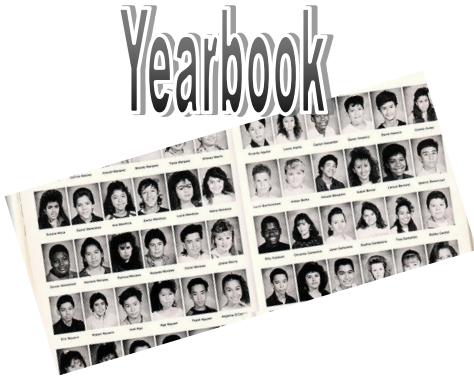
