Registration Reminder:

Registration for 2025-2026 is NOW. Your 2024-2025 tuition must be up to date and 2025-2026 fees paid in order to register your child/children for next school year! If you have a question regarding your tuition/fees, the financial account can be checked through the family portal.

Families with 1st–12th grade students for next school year will receive an invitation email to re-enroll your student(s), and do not have to come in person.
