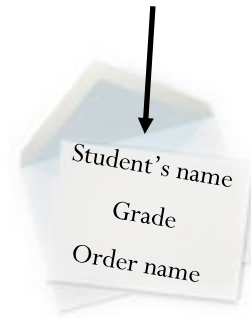

CORRECT PROCEDURE FOR RETURNING ORDERS:

Please remember, when returning orders and money to use **separate payments.** Each program is handled separately and orders and payment should be returned in separate **envelopes** labeled correctly. Please **do not staple** checks or cash to order forms; they are too

easy to tear getting them loose. If you use envelopes as we ask, there shouldn't be any need to use staples. **Enclose both the payment and the order form** in the envelope! **Please use a separate form for each child for every order, unless otherwise instructed.**

ALL FORMS FROM THE BLUE ORIENTATION FOLDER ARE DUE NOW:

If you have not returned the forms that were enclosed in your child's blue orientation folder, please do so **THIS** week.

If you have not looked through that folder, please take time to do so. There are many very important reminders of our school policies that are included. **PLEASE** take notice, especially of how we ask orders to be returned: **separate** forms for each student, **DO NOT** combine payments, and **ENCLOSE BOTH the payment and the order form in the en-**

velope! **PLEASE** do not **staple or tape** the payment to the order form—they are very easy to tear!! If you use envelopes as we ask, there shouldn't be any need to use staples or tape. **Check** or the **CORRECT CASH** is greatly appreciated!

If you are returning the yellow medication form, you should return the medicine which you are giving permission for your child to take, **WITH** the form. The medicine you send in is kept in the nurse's office with the form and labeled with your child's

name and will **ONLY** be used for them. If you choose to give permission for your child to take the basic meds we have on hand (**K-12th grade ONLY**), please remember to turn in the OTC form with the \$5 fee.

Since the "Warrior Wear" orders are not due until next Friday, they can be returned at that time.
